Blessing Activity Example: Processing Pain Lesson 7

Name - Tommy, your name is of Aramaic origin. The name is borne in the Bible by an apostle named Thomas who doubted the resurrection. The name means "Twin." Every twin has a match. Scripture – Lord, Your Word says You run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to give strong support to those whose heart is blameless. I pray You find Tommy's heart blameless. Lord, Your Word says, "that without faith, it is impossible to please You. For those who come to You must believe that You are, and that You are a rewarder of those who diligently seek You" (Heb. 11:6). I pray, Tommy, you will be diligent in seeking your God and that you find Him faithful. Tommy, I pray you will always be filled with the fruit of your salvation. When you do this, then righteous character will be produced in your life by Jesus Christ. This will bring much glory and praise to your God.

Blessing – You O' Lord, are Elyashib, The God Who Restores. I pray You will restore the relationship with Tommy's children and his family. I pray You will restore what the worm has devoured.
