- **Pocket Principle**®: a brief essay that focuses on a single lesson necessary for the growth and maturity of a believer.
- Guided Discussion: a group of questions based on the content in the Pocket Principle® ideally discussed within a small group. The major goal of the Guided Discussion is to encourage the application of the principles being discussed.
- **Teaching Outline**: an outline of the topics and subtopics covered in a specific lesson. These are useful for presenting or teaching Pocket Principles® to others.
